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Artistic Statement

As a stage manager, I strive for a warm and welcoming environment, throughout the entire process. Cultivating a *community* is paramount. I am a people-oriented/human centered stage manager. I will always put more emphasis on the person rather than the procedure. I would rather the procedure work for the person, then the person work for the procedure. If something isn't working, we change our approach to the procedure, not have the person change. I have witnessed that this makes the person feel safer and ensures that they are doing their best at their job.

Additionally, I don't want the directors table to be a barrier between me or anybody in the company. Whether that be the actors or the design team., You'll only find me behind the table during actual rehearsal time. If it's before, after or during breaks I am around and talking to people, getting to know them, trying to build a connection. I want all personnel to feel like I'm their shoulder to lean on, if they need it.

I believe that being in a position of power, if I'm confident others will follow suit. But having that "power" doesn't mean I'll play into the hierarchy. On my stage management team and in the room everyone's voice is just as important as mine. Just because I have to make the decision sometimes, doesn't mean my way is always the correct and best way.

Performance Report

Performance Notes:

1. Tonight's audience was very vocal. The audience laughed at moments that haven't had a reaction in a while. The actors thoroughly enjoyed this for their first show back. It appeared that many friends and theatre students were in the audience, which is always comforting.
2. For tonight's performance T. Vazquez went on for the role of Man with Scar Tissue
 - a. J. Fuentes missed his 6:00pm call and did not inform stage management he would be late. At 6:15pm Stage Management reached out to check in and see if everything was ok. J. Fuentes told stage management that would be arriving at/before 6:40pm for mic check. At 6:42pm, J. Fuentes was still not there and Stage Management received a text from him saying he was still on the way. Around 6:50pm Stage Management tried calling J. Fuentes to see how long it would be until he arrived, however he did not answer. We had T. Vazquez onstage and ready at 6:55pm completing mic check for the loud Scar Tissue moments. J. Fuentes was still not at the theatre, therefore Stage Management moved forward with appropriate measures to have T. Vazquez play the role during this performance. Stage Management checked in with costumes, to see if it was feasible to do the makeup plot for Scar Tissue, if T. Vazquez still went on for Man with Ice Cream and costumes thought it was enough time. At 6:59pm J. Fuentes arrived after mic check had been completed with T. Vazquez. Stage Management pulled him aside and let him know that T. Vazquez would be going on for the role tonight.

Technical Notes:

1. For Costumes/Props/Technical Director: Unfortunately the wings were not functional again at tonight's performance. They would not open and remained closed for the duration of the performance. It seemed like everything about them was normal and correct, but when the switch was flipped they wouldn't not open. Could we look into this tomorrow?
2. For Technical Director: During intermission tonight, the rope for the pulley system on the trash curtain in the Stage Right caliper was tied to a block to keep it up while the top half of Marisol's apartment was being struck. However, the knot ended up being too tight to untie when we needed to close it so we had to cut the rope. Could we get this repaired for tomorrow's performance?
3. For Technical Director: Would it be possible to take a look at the compressor under Marisol's apartment before the performance tomorrow? Although it's been charged

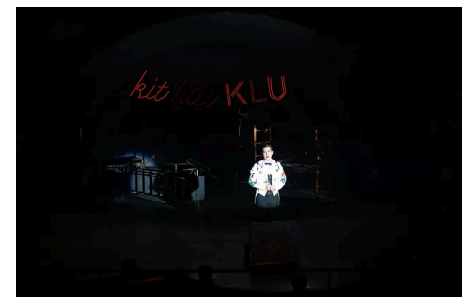
